For the control of a large range of emerged broadleaf and grass weeds on gravel paths and driveways, along fence lines and other areas where long-term weed control is required. Controls weeds for up to 4 months.

READ LABEL BEFORE USE

PRECAUTIONS:

Avoid inhalation of mist or spray. Wear a disposal face mask or similar. May cause serious eye irritation. Avoid getting product, mist or spray in eyes, wear eye protection when using. Coveralls and gloves are recommended. Keep children and pets off treated area until spray has dried. Do not allow spray or container to enter waterways, stormwater, or ponds.

FIRST AID:

Wash exposed skin with soap and cool water immediately after use. If exposed or concerned seek medical advice.

IF IN EYES: rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and safe to do so. Continue rinsing. If irritation persists call the Poisons Centre (0800 766 764) or a doctor, have product label to hand.

SPILLAGE:

Exclude non-essential people from the area. Wear PPE and avoid walking through spill. Bund area, stop leak if safe to do so. Absorb spill with inert material such as soil or sand, etc. and collect. Place collected material in sealable plastic bags or drums for disposal at the registered landfill. Area may be cleaned with water.

If material enters stormwater or a stream, etc., immediately contact the Local or Regional Council.

STORAGE:

Store in original container, tightly closed and securely away from children, pets or food.

DISPOSAL:

Dispose excess product by applying as per label or via a registered landfill or chemical disposal company.

Ensure container is completely empty. Triple rinse the empty container with water; dispose of washings by adding to spray tank. Recycle through the Agrecovery programme. If this is not possible, bury in an approved landfill or other approved facility.

DO NOT burn or reuse the container for any other purpose.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

BIO WEED BLAST LONG TERM is a non-selective herbicide used on non-productive land:

- On, or along the edges of, gravel paths and driveways.
- Along fence-lines.
- Around roadside furniture, signs, and power poles, etc.
- Other non-productive land

RESTRICTIONS:

For strip or spot spraying using ground-based equipment only. Not to be applied in a wide and dispersive manner. Not to be applied aerially.

- Not for use on food or feed producing crops or where stock have access to graze.
- Must not applied onto or into water.

It is recommended that the substance is not used in adverse wind conditions. **DO NOT** allow spray to contact or drift onto non-target plants. **DO NOT** apply in an agricultural setting or in a wide dispersive manner. **DO NOT** allow the substance or containers to get into water or waterways, including drains, ditches, sewers, streams, and ponds. **DO NOT** allow children or domestic pets entry into treated areas until the spray has dried.

DIRECTIONS OF USE:

For application using hand-help pressure sprayer, back-pack spray or hand-gun or for strip spraying using ground-based equipment.

Mix 40 ml of product with 1 litre of water in spray tank (4-litres per 100-litres). Fill the tank with half the amount of water and add BIO WEED BLAST LONG TERM. Agitate to ensure thorough mixing before adding the remaining water.

Shake or agitate tank mix before use.

Apply as a fine spray ensuring weeds are thoroughly wetted. Do not spray in conditions likely to result in spray drift onto desirable plants. If desirable plants or lawns are accidentally sprayed, hose immediately with water to minimise damage.

BIO WEED BLAST LONG TERM should immediately suppress any growth of weeds. Expect visible results within 24 hours and complete death between 1-4 weeks dependant on weed species.

COMPATABILITY:

BIO WEED BLAST LONG TERM is compatible with spray marker dyes, but should not be applied with any other products. A wetter or penetrant is not required.

RESISTANCE MANAGEMENT:

Group **2** Herbicide

BIO WEED BLAST LONG TERM contains the active ingredient imazapyr, which belongs to the imidazolines (IMIs) family of herbicides. Some naturally occurring weeds may become resistant when excessive use of the same herbicide occurs. To minimise this periodically use a herbicide from a different group when spraying the same area.

This product must not be used for any purpose or in any manner contrary to the controls and conditions of registration and the details outlined on this label. Any person purchasing, handling, or disposing of this product must be suitably qualified.
