## READ LABEL BEFORE USE

### PRECAUTIONS

This product must not be applied into or onto water. Avoid contamination of any water supply, water ways with product or empty container. Take all reasonable steps to ensure that the substance does not cause any significant adverse effects to the environment beyond the application area.

### PERSONAL PROTECTION

Avoid contact with skin and eyes, ingestion and inhalation of spray mist. When mixing or applying this product, overalls, boots, gloves and eye protection should be worn. Do not eat, drink or smoke while using. Remove protective clothing and wash hands and face thoroughly before meals and after work. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

### STORAGE

Store in original container, tightly closed, in a secure, dry, cool and well-ventilated area avoiding direct sunlight and away from foodstuffs, fertilisers or seeds.

Store in accordance with the current version of NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals.

### EQUIPMENT

Apply only with appropriate, well-maintained and calibrated equipment in accordance with NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals.

### DISPOSAL

**PRODUCT DISPOSAL:** Dispose of this product only by according to the label directions or if this is not possible contact your supplier for advice.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL.** Triple rinse container and add rinsate to the spray tank. Recycle clean containers at an Agrecovery depot, or puncture and dispose of at an approved landfill. Do not burn. Do not re-use container for any other purpose.

### FIRST AID

If medical advice is needed have product container or label to hand.

If swallowed or inhaled: Seek immediate medical advice. If in eyes, skin or hair - rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. If irritation occurs seek medical advice. If medical advice is needed have the product label on hand.

### SPILLAGE

Exclude non-essential people from the area. Wear protective clothing and prevent chemical from entering waterways. Absorb liquid spills with inert material such as attapulgate, sand, soil, etc., and place in a dedicated waste container. Wash area with water and absorb with further inert material. Dispose of safely at an approved landfill. DO NOT allow concentrate, solution or spray drift to come into contact with desirable surfaces such as motor vehicle paint work.

### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Weed Weapon Blue Dye is a temporary blue pattern indicator for use in many agricultural, turf and industrial applications. It is best used with a suspension concentrate type formulation to show up against the green vegetation. The bright blue colour shows you exactly where liquid pesticides and fertilisers have been applied. It helps to prevent skips and overlaps, and aids in detecting spray drift.

### COMPATIBILITY

Compatible with most pesticides and foliar fertilisers, however a small trial is recommended.

### THIS PRODUCT SHOULD NOT BE APPLIED ON FOOD OR FEED PRODUCING CROPS.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

A suggested starting rate is 250-300 mL per 100 L of spray mix. Before application, stir or mix the product thoroughly. Add the desired amount of Weed Weapon Blue Dye into a partially filled spray tank after the pesticide or foliar fertiliser has been added. Continue filling the tank with water while agitating to ensure the dye is fully dispersed.

The appropriate dosing rate depends on the terrain being treated, the intensity of colour required, and the duration the marker needs to remain visible. Users should adjust the dosage to suit their specific needs, balancing visibility with cost-effectiveness. A higher dose will produce a darker spray pattern.

### CLEANING AND DECONTAMINATION

After using spray equipment, flush all equipment and lines with clean water.
